What we've been doing this month:

We would like to start by thanking residents for their continued support and engagement with the Nunhead and Queens Road Safer Neighbourhood Team.

August has been a particularly challenging month for the team. Due to staffing pressures, we have had only one PCSO covering the ward throughout much of the month. In addition, PC Gardner has regularly been abstracted to assist with wider policing demands and staffing requirements across the borough.

Despite these challenges, officers have remained committed to providing a visible presence in the community and responding to issues affecting local residents

During August, officers were pleased to assist with a successful Day of Action at Peckham Pulse, working alongside a number of partner agencies including the Outreach Team and Housing Officers.

The event provided an excellent opportunity to engage with local residents and young people. A particular highlight was a surprise visit from the London Fire Brigade, who brought along a fire engine for children to explore. The visit was extremely popular and helped strengthen community engagement while promoting important safety messages.

We would like to thank all partner agencies involved for their support in making the day a success.

Officers from the team also supported policing operations at the Notting Hill Carnival over the Bank Holiday weekend. This annual event requires a significant policing presence, and local officers were proud to assist in ensuring the safety of the hundreds of thousands of people attending the celebrations.
