


DARKER NIGHTS

Store your key away from doors, windows, or any place it can be seen or easily located, for example, in a metal box

DARKER NIGHTS

Invest in a faraday bag - they are lined with metal material and can block the key's signal.

Test the wallet by placing the key inside and approaching your car to ensure the vehicle does not unlock when you stand next to it.
