

What should be reported?

You should report any behaviour that makes you feel unsafe, or you feel may make others unsafe. This includes:

- drug-related anti-social behaviour such as drug use or dealing and associated activities that cause disturbance
- youth-related anti-social behaviour and suspected gang activity
- threatening behaviour, verbal and physical threats and abuse
- vandalism and property damage
- using a property to sell drugs or for any other illegal activity
- harassment including incidents based on race, gender, religion, disability, or sexual orientation
- loud parties or gatherings causing disturbance, especially at night
- dog-related anti-social behaviour
- graffiti or flyposting such as sticking posters on walls and other public property
- littering or fly-tipping from an individual, business or vehicle on the streets, pavements or green spaces

How to report anti-social behaviour



We want to make sure Camden is safe for everyone. We know that anti-social behaviour can impact the quality of life for Camden residents, and that's why we've introduced new measures to investigate every report of anti-social behaviour.

Every incident of anti-social behaviour you report will help us to identify those involved and take action against them, or provide them with the right support if needed.

By reporting anti-social behaviour you are helping to keep Camden safe.

This leaflet details what anti-social behaviour is and how to report it.



What is anti-social behaviour?

This is any behaviour that makes you feel unsafe, or that you feel might make other people unsafe. This might be harassment, substance abuse and associated activities that cause disturbance, threatening behaviour, abuse, or vandalism and property damage.

This leaflet details examples of anti-social behaviour that you can report to the Police, the Council, the Responsive Security Patrol or other organisations.

Reporting anti-social behaviour incidents

- To report anti-social behaviour, or a crime that is taking place or about to take place call **999**
- The police number for non-emergencies is **101** (24 hours) or you can go online at: **met.police.uk/report**

- If you're a Camden Council tenant or leaseholder and anti-social behaviour happens on your estate between 4pm and 4am, call us on **020 7974 4444** and ask to be put through to Responsive Security Patrol
