Safer Winter Streets campaign is carrying on from Safer Streets Summer, focusing on business and community engagement across the beat to establish any issues and concerns raised.	See below for an update
General ASB: Neighbour disputes, McDonalds, fosse park, Nuisance Motorbikes and Drug taking have all been identified as a beat priority.	We continue to focus on e scooters across the beat by holding OP Pedal fast days to tackle the issues. Fosse park ASB is still being monitored in the coming months and the team are working with staff and security to alleviate some of the issues reported .
Issues with speeding, bikes and E-scooters as well as abandoned vehicles and vehicles obstructing	Residents have asked if we can do the speed awareness cameras on different parts of the beat so the team will arrange some days in the new year to complete these. Please drive safe over the winter months, we have seen an increase in road traffic collisions due to weather conditions and dark mornings. If you have any traffic issues please ring 101 or report online and also contact Blaby district council if you have any parking issues.

News

Storm Goretta arrived in some places last month and The Met Office issued an Amber Warning for heavy snow and strong winds. We received a large number of calls about vehicles succumbing to the weather and leaving occupants stranded. However, others including myself were left bitterly disappointed after Storm 'Forgetta' missed our homes entirely! During these colder months please remember when defrosting your car in the mornings, never leave it unattended with the engine running, opportunistic thieves take advantage of this this time of year and we tend to see a spike of theft **from** motor vehicles and theft **of** motor vehicles. Please be vigilant about your vehicle and your surroundings.

Our team, PC Meg, and PC Stickings from OP DETECT work to target repeat offenders of shop theft and other crimes in and around the Grove Triangle and Fosse Park area. A CBO is a court-issued order designed to tackle persistent offending. It can ban individuals from certain areas or behaviours and breaching it is a criminal offence. Thanks to strong partnership work and a persistent investigation, a prolific offender has now been remanded into custody and is facing the consequences. Retail crime isn't 'low-level', it's organised, repeat offending, and we're tackling it head-on. Last month we held beat surgeries and we gave advice and support to businesses and communities. We also gave away crime prevention tools.

We have been dealing with ongoing anti social behaviour in Narborough at the 24 hr Morrison's and the Blaby council offices over the last couple of months. I have been working to ID the youths involved and last month those youths that were identified causing issues have been visited in the presence of parents and been given a warning letter along with a banning letter from Morrison's. This warning letter is the second stage of our incremental approach and if anything further happens we move on to the next stage which helps us then to progress with things like Civil Injunctions, criminal behaviour orders or other sanctions if the problem persists. It was very good to see most parents were very proactive when spoken to.

Patrols have been completed around Hillbury Close, Narborough after receiving reports of vehicles parking all over the pavements and blocking drives, owners were suitably advised and we will monitor the situation.

We're investigating a number of recent shed break-ins reported across Narborough and Littlethorpe. Offenders have been targeting sheds and other outbuildings and focussing their attention on bicycles. Ensure sheds, garages, and outbuildings are securely locked, consider adding motion activated lighting or alarms and report any suspicious behaviour immediately.
