Welcome to this week's Crime and Team updates for Bordesley Green! We remain committed to supporting victims, preventing crime and maintaining strong links with our local community. Our officers have been actively engaging with schools, residents, and local partners to tackle issues head-on.

Domestic Abuse (DA)

7 incidents of domestic abuse were reported this week.

➡ If you or someone you know is experiencing domestic abuse, please don't suffer in silence. Help is available. We work closely with partner services to offer support and take all reports seriously.

Vehicle Crime

🚗 Incidents This Week:

- Thefts from Motor Vehicles: 7 (Locations: Porters Way, Blake Lane, Pretoria Road, Churchill Road, Bordesley Green, Yardley Green Road)

- Theft of Motor Vehicle: 1 on St Benedicts Road

➡ Vehicle crime continues to be a concern.
Tips: Use steering locks, Faraday pouches for keyless entry cars, and never leave valuables visible. Secure bikes with strong locks.

Robbery and Burglary

2 robberies involving personal property were reported.

➡ If confronted, do not resist. Try to remember key details such as the attacker's clothing, direction of travel, or any vehicle used.

Report all robberies immediately via 999.
1 attempted residential burglary on Farmer Road.

Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)

2 ASB incident reported.

➡ If you experience noise nuisance, intimidation, or disorderly behaviour, please report it. We work closely with housing providers and the council to manage repeat offenders.



Team Highlights

23/08/25 Priority meeting (Priority Setting Update)

Following our recent meeting, two main priority areas have been identified:

- Ideal Village (Daniels Rd & Finnemore Rd): Drug dealing, ASB, and dumped vehicles.
- Coventry Road (Heybarnes Rec – Muntz St): Drug dealing, ASB, and issues linked to 24-hour shops.

These priorities will guide our focus from 1st September, though we will continue to address concerns across the wider neighbourhood.
