E-SCOOTERS | KNOW THE LAW



We understand that buying an e-scooter can be tempting, HOWEVER, it is against the law to ride an e-scooter on a UK public road, cycle path or pavement. The only place an e-scooter can be used is on private land (with the landowner's permission).

E-scooters are classified as Personal Light Electric Vehicles (PLEVs), so they are treated as motor vehicles and subject to the same legal requirements, such as: MOT, Tax, and Insurance.

What will happen if I am stopped by Police riding an e-scooter? Section 165A of the Road Traffic Act 1988, allows Police Officers and PCSO's to seize e-scooters. Once seized by the Police it can be disposed of in accordance with force policy. The rider of the e-scooter could also be prosecuted for driving offences.
