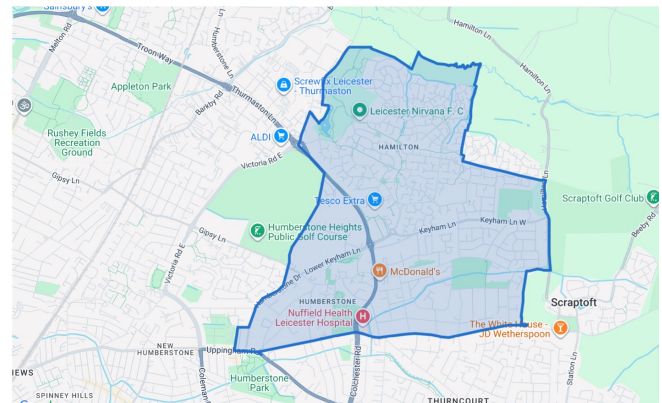
### Youths Causing Anti Social behaviour:

Our team has recently been dealing with an increase in anti-social behaviour involving local youths in and around the McDonald's on Netherhall Road. We want to reassure the community that we have taken firm and proactive steps to address these concerns. Officers have been engaging directly with the young people involved and have contacted their parents to ensure they are fully aware of the behaviour taking place.

Formal warning letters have also been issued, outlining the potential consequences should this behaviour continue. We remain committed to keeping the area safe and welcoming for everyone, and we will continue to work closely with parents, local businesses, and community partners to prevent further issues.

### Residential breaks and burglaries:

As the nights grow longer, it's important to take extra precautions to keep your home secure. Ensure all doors and windows are locked, even when you're at home, and consider using timer switches for lights to give the impression that someone is in. Avoid leaving valuables in plain sight and keep sheds and garages locked. If you have a security alarm or CCTV, make sure it's working properly. Most importantly, stay alert to suspicious activity in your area and report anything unusual to the police. A few simple steps can make a big difference in keeping your home and family safe.

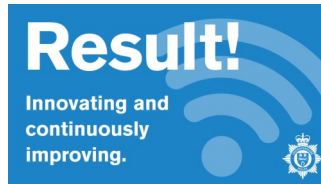
# #NE12 / Monthly Update

This week has been an exceptionally busy week for the NE12 Neighbourhood Team at Keyham Lane, following a series of vehicles within the NE12 beat area (Hamilton, Humberstone and Netherhall) being entered and property stolen from them. From the incidents reported, CCTV and statements were obtained and a suspect quickly identified and on Tuesday 12th May, this suspect was arrested and found with 3 knives on him. After some excellent teamwork from all the Neighbourhood Teams at Keyham Lane and also officers from Mansfield House, the suspect was interviewed for a series of thefts from motor vehicles along with some difficult questions relating to the knives that he had in his possession. Special mention to PC1026 Shaffi, who worked tirelessly to ensure that the suspect was charged with 6 offences and remanded into custody to appear at the next available court. As a result of the efforts of both teams involved, the suspect appeared at court and was sentenced to 8 months imprisonment and also was given a 3 year Criminal Behaviour Order preventing him entering a defined area where these thefts occurred. It is worth mentioning that these thefts occurred on insecure vehicles so I remind our communities to ensure that their vehicle is locked and secured to prevent them becoming victims of crime and finding property stolen from their vehicle.
