What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following from March 2025.

Priority 1: Significant rise in Drug Dealing and Drug Use. **What we are going to do:** High Visibility patrols around key locations to gather intelligence and information needed to identify drug dealers and users. Our aim is to seek out those involved in the supply of drugs to disrupt them and close down supply lines.

Priority 2: Speeding. **What we are going to do:** Following proactive high visibility patrols around targeted areas, we have seen a significant rise of speeding. Over the beat surgeries speeding has been an issue overall from people who have attended. As a beat team we have completed a few speed ops, in the Wolds and in and around the Seagrave area. We have planned a few more speeding ops in and around the beat to combat this issue as speeding will not be tolerated in our villages.

Priority 3: Anti-Social Behaviour. **What we are going to do:** We have seen a recent rise of anti social behaviour at Mill Lane, Haines drive and the Poppyfields estate. Anti-social behaviour on Motorbikes and off road bikes has seen a significant rise. We will be actively patrolling these areas, if the bikes are being ridden in an anti social manner or likely to be involved in anti social behaviour, the bikes can be seized under section 59. We are also conducting high visibility patrols daily, and we have asked partner beats to help conduct patrols when we are not on shift. Furthermore in the eve-
