## Is it an emergency?

in emergency situations like these:

- There is an immediate danger to life.
- Someone is using violence or is threatening to be violent.
- A crime is happening right now, like a house burglary or a theft.
- The suspect is still at the scene.

## If it's not an emergency.

If you've witnessed or been the victim of crime that isn't an emergency, it is important that you still report it to us.

You can report non emergency incidents via phoning 101 or online by going to the Metropolitan police website and filling out an online form.
