#YouSaidWeDid - What matters to you

Priority 1: Anti-social Behaviour in and around Braunstone Park, Cort Crescent and Gallards Hill

You said: Anti-Social Behaviour in and around Braunstone Park continues as a priority concern from the community. With Halloween and Bonfire night approaching, the team will continue to concentrate on this location.

We Did: The team continue to conduct high visibility patrols on Braunstone park and the surrounding area. The location is also a hot spot area for the nightly ASB car. This has so far resulted in a reduced number of calls regarding ASB at the location. The team are also exploring some additional funding that could potentially enhance the area further. Watch this space!!

Priority 2: Road Safety

You Said: From Community Surveys and Feedback on Neighbourhood Link, road safety has been highlighted to be a local concern. We will continue to concentrate on speeding concerns and anti social behaviour caused by e bikes, e scooters and off road motorbikes.

We Did: The team have now conducted multiple Op Pedalfast operations in Braunstone and Rowley Fields. This has resulted in 39 e scooters and 38 e bikes being seized since 22nd August. It has also resulted in a stolen motorbike being recovered, a stolen bike being recovered and multiple arrests for other offences.

Your feedback has been very positive and we will continue to take illegal vehicles off the roads and footpaths. The team have also executed tester speed enforcement operation on streets across the beat. Again, this has produced good feedback from the community and will look at upping the number of those operations.

Priority 3: Anti-social Behaviour (Drug related)

You Said: From the Surveys on Neighbourhood Link you have told us that drug dealing and usage at locations across the Braunstone and Rowley Fields area is a concern.

We Did: For the year to date, the team have executed 10 Misuse of Drugs Act warrants this year. This is based on the information that you, the community tell us about. This is in addition to multiple arrests that occur for drugs related offences across the beat. The team are currently in the process of obtaining further warrants, so watch this space!!

Good news

December activities:

- PCSOs Beth, Julie and Geoff attended the Community Christmas Fair at The Grove Community Hub. It was a fantastic event, and was amazing to see members of the community coming together to celebrate this festive season!
- PCs George, Chelsea and Paige secured 11 charges for a youth causing issues across the beat area. They also secured 15 charges for another youth. Offences for both include theft, assault emergency worker, and public order.
- PCSO Geoff responded to a report of a burnt out vehicle on Braunstone Park. He worked his magic and managed to obtain a VIN to identify the vehicle. Park wardens have been made aware and will be removing the eyesore as soon as they can.
- PC Ryan obtained a Section 8 warrant for an address on Harlaxton Street. With teamwork from SGT Craig, PCs Chelsea, George, Paige and PC Phil—from a neighbouring beat—entry was gained. Unfortunately, the suspected cannabis grow had been moved prior to officers visiting.
- PCSOs Beth and Julie, along with PCs George and Ryan and PC Sam—from our Safer Streets Team worked together to identify and arrest a male who committed multiple high value shop theft from a shop on Narborough Road. He spent his day in court, was given a 12 month sentence and also given a Criminal Behaviour Order (CBO) preventing him from entering specific areas.
