Untaxed Vehicles

In June we conducted a joint operation with the DVLA to tackle untaxed vehicles across our constituency. We have received positive feedback on this and will be look to doing more regular operations.



Parking Issues

Parking remains a priority issue for the community and an issue we have been taking immediate action against. Double parking and blocked pavements create a large risk to pedestrians who may have to cross in to the middle of the road and is obstructive to other road users. On this one

day alone over 50 tickets were given out. These are virtual so you may not have known that those vehicles received a ticket

We were fortunate to be invited to a family fun day in Ward End park by Sladefield Primary School to represent the Washwood Heath Neighborhood team. Whilst there we were able to give away vehicle safety kits to parents and burglary prevention items. The kids even got some coloring, badg-
