What matters to you

From data collated from local surveys, beat knowledge, intelligence and reports made to Leicestershire Police, the following have been highlighted as priorities within the community.

Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB).

You said: General ASB is still an issue and continues across the beat.

We did: Verbal warnings were issued to two individuals who were identified as being involved in repeat ASB in the Saffron Lane estate after CCTV was obtained in the local area. Since then, there have been no repeat issues with patrols set to continue in this location. A report has also been created to tackle reports of ASB in the Knighton Lane East area/Aylestone Recreational ground with work ongoing with partner agencies and visible patrols in place.

Priority 2: Drug use and supply.

You said: Drug dealing, taking and cultivation is still happening in the local community.

We did: A cannabis grow was located on Lothair Road inside a property after a report of suspicious activity was made to police, officers gained entry to the address and discovered cannabis plants and cultivation equipment. The address has been cleared and an investigation is underway to identify those involved, a nearby vehicle was also seized as part of the ongoing enquires.

Priority 3: Specific ASB.

You said: There has been an increase in ASB in the Old Saffron Lane/Maris Lane area.

We did: There has been no significant reports of repeat ASB in these areas, it appears visible patrols and warnings issued at the start of the summer have been effective.
