## What matters to you:

**Priority 1: You told us that you were concerned about burglaries within the Oadby area.**

**What we are going to do:** Officers continue to conduct regular patrols of the areas where offences have occurred, these patrols are reducing the number of burglaries. We will continue to do this going forward. Where CCTV is available, this will provide valuable intelligence on times and when offences are happening and possible vehicles involved, to assist in our patrol strategy.

**Priority 2: Road Safety You said: You have told us that Road Safety is a priority, this includes things like Speeding, Insurance, MOT and driving offences.**

**What we are going to do:** We have conducted vehicle speed checks at identified locations. Local officers have been targeting motorist's speeding, not wearing seatbelts, using mobile phones and drink/drug driving. Local officers have received reports of identified vehicles being driven without valid insurance, MOT and tax.

**Priority 3: Anti-social Behaviour You Said: You have told us that Anti-Social behaviour causes you concern. This can be things like excessive noise, smoking drugs and more. We will be working with partners to ensure we can tackle these issues and reduce their occurrences.**

**What we are going to do:** Your local police beat team and response officers continue to patrol identified locations, as reported by yourselves with regards to anti-social behaviour and drug related incidents. Officers continue to stop check persons and vehicles who are involved in drugs. Local officers have identified vehicles which are related to criminality.

## **Tesco Express - Crime Prevention Event**

On Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> September 2025, your local neighbourhood policing team was out in the community, with PCSO Nad holding a crime prevention event at the Tesco Express. This was a great opportunity for residents to meet Nad, get advice on keeping their homes and property safe, and discuss any concerns they had directly with the policing team. These types of events provide options for residents, in accessing police services in the heart of their community without having to travelling to police station. ## **Tackling Illegal Parking at Oadby Schools**

The safety of our children during busy school pick-up and drop off times is important. During the week of Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2025 to Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> September 2025, the Oadby Neighbourhood Policing Team worked alongside the Council Civil Enforcement Officer to address the issue of illegal parking across various Oadby schools. This joint operation focused on ensuring compliance with parking restrictions to keep roads clear and safe for students, parents, and other pedestrians during drop-off and pick-up times. There were also vehicles which issued with penalty charge notices. We appreciate the support of the community as we work to make our schools safer. The following schools were visited: Langmoor Primary School, Woodland Grange Primary School, Launde Primary School, Beauchamp College, Gartree High School, Brocks Hill Primary, Manor High School and Brookside Primary School.
