What Matters to You

With data provided by our local community we have decided on our 3 beat priorities.

Priority 1:– Road Safety - This is our top priority based on NHL feedback and we are focused on issues such as Speeding, ASB Cars, E-bikes and e-scooters.

Priority 2: - You've told us through surveys and local engagement that there are issues around the anti-social and dangerous use of motorbikes, e-scooters and cars in the area of Braunstone park and the surrounding road network

Priority 3 - You've told us through surveys and local engagements that there are issues around drug use and supply at various locations across the beat, and the associated Anti-Social Behaviour.

What We have done #YouSaidWeDid



During the month of May we had our National Campaign - Op Sceptre which is to raise awareness of the law and dangers with knives. The local beat team has been engaging with members of the public, businesses, schools and our key communities partners to pass advice. #WeDontCarry

- Multiple shops visited
- Staff and public educated
- Leaflets provided to storefront
- Flyers handed out across the beat area
- Arrests and people on bail or waiting court dates.

Tackling nuisance motorbikes/E-scooters

Your local beat team have continued to follow up on any reports of motorbikes with a focus on finding source addresses and identifying the riders.

We will then seek to use all policing powers under the Road Traffic Act and ASB Powers to prosecute anyone found to be committing these offences.

Well will continue to patrol Braunstone Park and the surrounding streets as this is where most of the issues are highlighted.

Leicestershire Police have also re-launched the Safer Roads Team and they have been asked to come and support us at Braunstone and Rowley Fields Neighbourhood area in trying to deal with this matter.

Drug Use and Dealing associated at known addresses in the Neighbourhood area

Following months of working alongside Leicester City Council and the Community Safety Team we have **EVICTED** the tenants from a known address involved in Drugs and Criminality. Furthermore, LCC and Police have successfully repossessed 3 other premises that were closely linked to drugs and Anti-social behaviour.

These addresses have caused many issues on the Beat area for many years and by working closely with out partner agencies and attending court to enforce against the tenants these addresses have now finally been repossessed by Leicester City Council.

The hard work could not have been done without the continued support and reporting of issues by the local community and residents, and I encourage everyone to continue to ACT AND REPORT ALL ISSUES relating to Criminality and ASB as we can and WILL take action against those tenants who allow their homes to be used in such ways.



Community concerns on parks

Our green spaces should be a place our community feels safe so we are actively patrolling these more during the daylight hours as the members of the public have flagged concerns to us.

Whilst there have been several incidents on Braunstone Park in May and in particular the Stabbing of a person. The incident is believed to have been a targeted incident and the perpetrators have been identified and arrested promptly, minimising the risks posed to the wider community and public.

I am going to use this opportunity to recommend a great app called What.3.Words. It can pinpoint your location on large parks or fields, you then pass 3 words to emergency services to help them find you faster.
