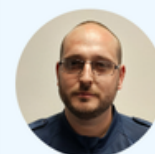

Updates



Northamptonshire Police has continued its proactive work under **Operation Relentless**, resulting in a successful period of enforcement activity across the Force area over April. The operation focuses on identifying and arresting individuals who are wanted, outstanding, or assessed as posing a high risk to the public, while also gathering intelligence to support future enforcement and safeguarding activity. Operation Red deploys dedicated officers to track, locate, and arrest individuals wanted for domestic abuse offences. By concentrating resources on outstanding suspects, the force can take early safeguarding action, speed up investigations, and deliver improved outcomes for victims. The initiative has already made a significant impact across the north of the county, with officers making more than 70 arrests in the first six weeks of Operation Red. A property in Daventry has been issued with a closure order following persistent issues with drugs and anti-social behaviour. The property in Crabtree House had seen ongoing reports of drug dealing, drug use and anti-social behaviour. People were often seen using drugs in communal areas and frequently behaving in a nuisance manner. The property has now been fully boarded up and residents have already expressed their relief and thanks. More information available [here](#).

Updates



A police and partnership approach to tackling crime and anti-social behaviour has helped reduce offending and improve police and community engagement on the Bouverie estate in Northampton, following a year of targeted action. Since May 2025, Northamptonshire Police has been working closely with West Northamptonshire Council and other partners as part of the Together we Solve project, using the Home Office Clear Hold Build approach. A 63-year-old man has been convicted of letting his dogs chase and injure sheep for the second time in less than a year. Lopez-Vidal had already been issued with a community protection warning letter following his first conviction, however after the recent attack in December, he has now been made subject of a one-year Community Protection Notice.
