What's Happening on the Day?

Skips and Waste Disposal

- **5 skips** will be placed across the estate- please see overleaf for locations
- Residents can dispose of excess household and garden waste
- Gas bottles will NOT be accepted
- We will not accept waste from people arriving by car to use the skips, waste can be taken to Raikes Lane Waste & Recycling Centre

Litter Picking

- Supported by Bolton at Home staff
- Residents are welcome to join in
- All equipment provided
- **Meeting point:** Within Ucan, 39 Kentmere Road
- Refreshments and hot dogs will be provided for all volunteer litter pickers 

How You Can Prepare

Residents are encouraged to:

- Remove unwanted items from gardens before the action day - this is your chance to get your garden or communal area ready for spring
- Use the on-site skips provided
- Ask staff for help if needed – support will be available on the day
