

# Stay Alert when withdrawing cash

- **Be aware of your surroundings –**

Take a moment to look around before you make your transaction.

- **Be aware of people standing too close –**

If someone is crowding you or trying to look over your shoulder, pause your transaction and wait for space. If the issue persists stop your transaction.

- **Withdrawing a large sum? –**

Ask staff if a private room or secure area is available – it's there for your safety.

- **If you see something, say something**


– Report anything that feels unusual, suspicious, or out of place before, during or after your transaction.

- **Trust your instincts –**

If something doesn't feel right, don't be afraid to alert staff. Your safety comes first.

- **Notice repeat behaviour –**

Be cautious of individuals who linger or keep returning to the machine without using it.
