Teenager jailed for 29 years for murder of Cameron Bailey 🧸

Following an investigation by our Major Crime Unit, Jayden Gubetini, pictured, has been jailed for a minimum of 29 years following a hearing at Reading Crown Court.

Gubetini is a dangerous individual who, despite his age, has demonstrated his intent to repeatedly use serious violence.

Too often, we are reminded of the danger of carrying and using knives, the devastating consequences and the impact such a short moment in time has on the victim, their family and friends.

Harsher consequences have now been brought in, meaning you will end up in court and habitual offenders will trigger mandated minimum sentences more quickly. There are no second chances.

Gubetini will now face the consequences of his actions by serving a significant custodial sentence, reflecting the gravity of the offences committed.

At the conclusion of this tragic case, our thoughts remain with the family of Cameron Bailey and his friend at this difficult time.



The Wycombe neighbourhood team have been putting up Crimestoppers posters around the Castlefield and Downley areas while out on their patrols this week 🖁 🚜


This is to encourage the increased reporting of anti-social behaviour and any other offences that may be witnessed by residents in their local community.

"Police Officers from the Beaconsfield Neighbourhood Team were back at Beaconsfield Services, assisting specialist officers from the Modern Slavery and Organised Immigration Crime (MSOIC) Team.

As part of an ongoing operation in response to a number of targeted thefts from trailers and containers, we provided a highly visible presence in the lorry park area. We spoke to several lorry drivers in order to give them security advice about keeping themselves, their vehicles, and cargo safe. It was also an opportunity to talk to the lorry drivers about their experiences with migrants concealing themselves in vehicles that are destined for the UK, including unaccompanied asylum seeking children, members of organised criminal gangs, and victims of modern slavery. This help an intelligence picture in order to disrupt illegal activity and safeguard vulnerable people".

Following recent reports of parcel theft from streets around Chalfont St Peter, officers have been patrolling the area. Although nobody wants to miss a delivery, unattended parcels are vulnerable to theft. Here are some steps to help keep your parcels secure:

Vehicle abandoned in #FulmerFord since last Sunday. Removed by local Neighbourhood Team as causing an obstruction. #C7958 #C6801

- · Instruct parcel companies not to leave parcels when you're not at home
- · Opt for a parcel to be delivered to a 'safe place' where it is out of sight/locked away
- Consider opting for delivery to a parcel locker some companies have lockers in nearby places allowing you to collect when you're available
- · Consider if there is a trusted person who would be happy to keep a parcel secure for you
- · Consider CCTV and CCTV warning stickers covering your doorstep and property
- · Consider installing a security light


