What we've been doing this month:

This month we are saying goodbye and 'Good luck!' to PCSO Peduto, as he will be starting his journey to becoming a police officer on the 3rd August! We hope he has a great time!

During July, the neighbourhood policing team continued their work across the ward focusing on crime prevention, anti-social behaviour issues, reassurance patrols, and community engagement.

Officers focused on priority areas, such as Meeting House Lane, Culmore Road and Carlton Grove, due to street gatherings, drinking and playing loud music causing disturbances to residents. SNT have already issued a number of Community Protection Warnings (CPWs) and Community Protection Notices (CPNs) to those individuals.

PC Gardner arrested someone who committed a serious sexual offence.

Officers have conducted welfare and reassurance visits across the ward following reports of burglaries around Kirkwood Road and St Mary's Road; to provide support and words of advice to residents.

The team completed several training courses, such as Anti-Social Behaviour, community engagement course and ASB Warning, Community Protection Warning (CPW) and Community Protection Notice (CPN) course.

Making us a more able SNT for the community! With this last in mind; Officers continue to work with partner agencies to reduce ASB on the ward.
