Current Ward Priorities


Our ward priorities very much remain the same.


Shoplifting – Appears to still be ongoing, however we are continuing to work with the Brighton Crime Reduction Partnership (BCRP) and local businesses to address this. We encourage businesses and locals to put in reports whenever there has been shoplifting however big or small.

Anti-social behaviour & drug-related activity – Regular patrols continue in known hotspots. There have been drug taking activities in and around the Sainsbury's Lewes Road car park. There continues to be patrols in this area.
