## News

We've continued with lots of high-visibility patrols across the beat area but we've seen a small increase in burglaries in Countesthorpe and the surrounding villages, however, there have been some positive arrests made. Please take a moment to ensure your homes, sheds, garages and vehicles are secure. A few simple precautions can go a long way.

On the 06 June, I met with the Environment Agency at the Countesthorpe Country Park. We both carried out patrols around the park / ponds, working together on this day, to provide a visible presence and engaged with members of the public. We saw the burnt-out bench beside one of the ponds. We both want to ensure that the park remains a safe and enjoyable place for everyone to come to, however, because of the issues that the Environment Agency and Blaby District Council have had in the park, you will see the Environment Agency a lot more. Collaboration working really does make a difference. It was all hands-on deck at the Countesthorpe Country Park on the 08 June for Operation PEDALFAST. Officers and the NH23 Beat Sergeant walked around our parks, heading towards Blaby shopping centre, the aim was to seize any e-bikes or e-scooters. None were noted on this occasion but Offices are still monitoring this.

We received reports of people jumping over fences in Countesthorpe; however, we had not been given a time frame, starting point and how many people? This information came via our online system. I had tried to make contact with the informant but to no avail. When reporting in online, please place as much information in as possible.

Brook Court invited me to their Social Club meeting after my Beat Surgery at The Bridge in Countesthorpe. As a result of attending the Social Club meeting, I have helped support a vulnerable gentleman and organised Beavers to get in touch with Brook Court.
