#YouSaid - What matters to you.

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following in February 2025.

Priority 1: Theft

You said: You told us that you were concerned about thefts, this can include shop thefts and vehicle break ins in the area. We will try to prioritise this going forward.

Priority 2: Motor vehicle crime

You Said: you told us that you were concerned about vehicle crime this includes anything from theft of vehicle to theft from vehicle.

Priority 3: Road Safety

You Said: You have told us that road safety is a priority, this includes speeding, dangerous driving, no insurance, no MOT, no tax and more.

#WeDid - What we are doing

As part of our ongoing priorities in Lutterworth, we have been focusing on thefts, vehicle crime, and road safety.

- **Thefts:** We have carried out targeted patrols around local shops and car parks, identifying and dealing with known offenders. We've also engaged with businesses to provide crime prevention advice and strengthen links with shop staff.
- **Vehicle crime:** We have increased evening patrols in hotspot areas, spoken to residents about simple security steps they can take to secure their property.
- **Road safety:** We have conducted speed checks in areas raised by the community and offered visible reassurance patrols around schools at peak times. We continue to work with partners to highlight the dangers of speeding and inconsiderate parking.

Policing Update

We would like to inform the community that **Inspector Chris Day** has taken on the role of **Neighbourhood Policing Area (NPA) Commander** for the Lutterworth area. Inspector Day has taken over from **Inspector Perry**, who has moved on to a new role.

Inspector Day is committed to maintaining strong community engagement and continuing proactive policing across the town and surrounding villages.

Prolific Shoplifter Arrested and Charged

On **22 April 2026**, officers arrested **Craig Randall**, a known prolific shoplifter, in relation to ongoing theft offences affecting local businesses.

- Mr Randall was **charged with five counts of theft**
- He was **remanded in custody overnight** to attend court the following morning
- At court, he was issued with a **two-year Criminal Behaviour Order (CBO)**

This order provides **significant protection for local stores and the wider town**, placing restrictions on Mr Randall's behaviour and allowing police to act swiftly should the order be breached. We would like to thank local retailers for their continued reporting and cooperation, which was vital in securing this outcome.

Stolen Motorhome Recovered the Same Day

On **28 April 2026**, officers successfully located and recovered a **stolen motorhome on the same date it was reported stolen**.

The vehicle was fitted with a **tracker**, which enabled police to identify its location quickly and recover it without delay. This incident highlights how vehicle tracking technology can be extremely valuable in helping police retrieve stolen vehicles and minimise disruption and loss to owners.
