You Said	We did
Burglaries have become a force Priority. Burglaries in the 20 beat area include car-key breaks, residential, aggravated breaks, attempt breaks and business burglaries.	A burglary was reported at a business premises on Dorsey Way, Enderby. The perpetrators were disturbed by staff before anything could be taken. CCTV work is currently being undertaken.
Complaints have been received at various locations within the beat area regarding general ASB including nuisance motorbikes and ASB issues on the fosse park area including McDonalds.	The beat team have been made aware of youths on E-Scooters riding dangerously around Holland Way, Narborough. Patrols of the area are in place.
Road safety is a concern for us on the NH20 beat. This involves speeding on the main busy roads and within residential areas, parking around school zones at pick up and drop of time. Inconsiderate parking on corners and in dangerous positions, blocking pavements and causing pedestrians to have to walk on the road and any abandoned vehicles. News

Proactive patrols have been carried out by PCSO Sarah and PCSO Ryan across the NH20 Beat which consists of Narborough, Enderby, New Lubbethorpe, Littlethorpe and Fosse Park. I am happy to report that the priorities for these areas were covered quite heavily and a positive result was had. No nuisance motorcycle riders were found across the beat, no ASB at Fosse Park and proactive burglary hot spot patrols throughout Narborough were completed.

Further patrols throughout the evening we did spot quite a few high performance and highly modified vehicles entering the area of Fosse Park from Soar Valley Way. All the usual hot spots of car cruising, gathering and racing were covered and I am happy to report that all was well and lawful during our shift.

We have received a report in relation to a manmade ramp/bridge on Pimpernel Close in Narborough. We are not the 'Fun Police' and don't want to stop children enjoying themselves however it appears this has become somewhat popular and is now causing quite a bit of ASB for local residents with youths being loud and verbally abusive to local residents. One child has already broken their arm. The beat team are aware and will be monitoring this.

PCSO 6592 Danny & PC 4258 Dave found a suspiciously dumped, lonely looking Renault Clio in New Lubbethorpe and after a few police checks on the vehicle all became clear. The vehicle had no road tax and although it wasn't seen to be driving, was still showing to have no insurance, so we decided to get this off the road and recovered using our DVLA Powers. After having a delightful conversation with one local resident who decided to be quite confrontational with ourselves, we hope we managed to educate him on the basics of taxing and insuring a vehicle.
