What matters to you

Priority 1: Burglaries.

You said: Burglaries are a concern for the neighbourhood.

We did: With the earlier darker nights upon us, we are continuing with our work towards reducing the opportunities for dwelling burglaries across Knighton, by working with residents and partner agencies.

Priority 2: Vehicle related Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)

You Said: There is an increase in anti-social vehicles in the area of Laureston Drive.

We Did: We will continue with a high visibility presence and deal with any reports of ASB, utilising Section 59 Police Reform Act and s23 Misuse of Drugs Act available to us.

Priority 3: .

You said: Road safety is a continuing concern across Knighton, this will include the use of e-scooters, our Christmas Drink Drive campaign and speeding.

We did: We will continue to address this concern and tackle the use of illegal vehicles, e scooter/bikes, through enforcement and seizure of the vehicles. We have recently conducted a joint operation with Clarendon Park colleagues, 11 E-scooters / E-Bikes were seized.



Other Local News

This time of year with the earlier darker nights, historically we see an increase in residential Burglaries. Despite the increase, since 2019, we have seen an overall reduction in this type of crime year on year. We will continue to conduct high visibility patrols and maintain a strong policing presence in the community and continue the trend.

- **Keep doors and windows locked,** even when you're at home.
- Install motion-sensor lighting around entrances and driveways.
- Trim hedges and bushes to eliminate hiding spots for intruders.
- Secure sheds and garages—burglars often target tools and bikes stored there
