# What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following from September 2025.

## Priority 1: Drug issues. What we are going to do-

Drug issues remain one of our beat priorities, the team have recently been listening to intelligence you have been providing us with and reports you have been making, we are using this to identify problem areas and understand where more intelligence needs to be gathered. The team have recently successfully identified individuals of note and worked together to deliver ASB advice/warning letters to deter this behaviour, as well as continuing high visibility patrols. If you have any concerns, you can report them online, or anonymously via crimestoppers. Alternatively, you can find your local PCSO at any beat surgery if you wish to have a chat.

#### Priority 2: Nuisance motorbikes. What we are going to do-

The beat team have noticed a recent rise in nuisance motorbikes in hotspot areas, and as a result extra patrols have been put in place to at all different times of day to deter this behaviour. Enquiries are also being undertaken to identify those responsible.

# Priority 3: Retail theft. What we are going to do-

The beat team continue to work closely with staff of retail shops and have been carrying out high visibility patrols and engagements to deter shoplifting, as well as conducting CCTV enquiries to identify those responsible, the beat team have recently seen a drop in shop thefts and will work to continue this decline.
