## What matters to you

- **Priority 1**

### What you have said

You have stated that Anti-Social Behaviour is a concern within the Charnwood East area.

### Action taken

The core priorities will remain the same and will be adapted to specific areas as demand dictates. Patrols have continued in areas highlighted as concerns with ASB. Patrols have been conducted around Hilltop Road and Lady Acre in Thorpebury in the Limes following reports of motorbikes at the location. Additionally, patrols have taken place in Syston town and Thurmaston shopping centre to address disruptive behaviour by youths. Officers have also attended Thurmaston retail park in response to the car cruise. Checkland Road has seen patrols due to reports of anti-social behaviour (ASB), concerns regarding drug taking, and the use of a quad bike on the road. Patrols will continue at these locations and any newly identified areas to ensure community safety.

- **Priority 2**

### What you have said

The community has also stated that speeding and parking issues are a concern at various locations throughout the Charnwood East area.

### Action taken

Speed operations have taken place on Barkby Road in Queniborough, and Melton road in Thurmaston. Following a report of an abandoned vehicle, the beat team attended and found the vehicle to be stolen; it was forensically recovered. The team also visited Thurmaston Brownies and spoke to the children about road safety. Additionally, they provided general information, including road safety, to the children at Broomfield School East Goscote holiday club. Further operations are planned in areas highlighted as concerned.

- **Priority 3**

### What you have said

There has been a recent increase in residential burglaries within Charnwood East area.

### Action taken

After reports of burglaries at Thorpebury in the Limes, high visibility patrols have taken place and the team have liaised with the site management. Patrols have also been conducted around Syston, Thurmaston, East Goscote, Rearsby, and Thrussington. The ASB car has also completed patrols around the villages. The team continue to work with our CID colleagues to support investigations and provide reassurance to all involved. The team will adjust their patrols plans to incorporate those areas affected to provide reassurance and assist with any enquiries.

# The Beat Team News

Everyday your local beat team are conducting marked Police car patrols through the villages of Charnwood East. These villages are Syston, Thurmaston, Thrussington, East Goscote, Ratcliffe on the Wreake, Barkby, Barbky Thorpe, Beeby, Rearsby, Hamilton Lea, Queniborough, South Croxton and Thorpebury in the Limes.

Thank you to those who came to our beat engagements this month. Thank you to those for raising their concerns and for all the positive feedback.



Patrols have taken place around Thorpebury in the limes in relation to ASB on motorbikes and burglaries on the building sites.

On 06/03, the beat team conducted speed operations with a speed gun in locations as followed:

- Melton Road in Thurmaston

- Barkby Road in Queniborough.



On 19/04 PCSO 6024, PC 196 and PC 1651 conducted a beat engagement at the Quenibean café in Queniborough.



## Crime prevention advice:

Please remain vigilant and report any suspicious activity without delay and if you feel a crime is in progress then call 999 and take this time to review your own security.

Check your lock barrels - if they do not have a 3 star rating, which are anti-snap security cylinder which provide the best protection against known cylinder attacks methods, then you could and should consider replacing/upgrading them.

Look at having a security light fitted, alongside good quality CCTV and ensure that windows and doors are left locked and secure and do not leave valuables on display - this can include empty boxes of that new PSS, iPad or similar.

Alongside this check how accessible your rear garden is - fix that lock on the gate, replace that fence panel - also a brilliant deterrent is some defensive planting around the perimeter of rear gardens.

Keep your property secure with these useful crime prevention tips



The beat team have been conducting burglary patrols around the NL61 beat, which consists of evening foot and marked car patrols throughout the villages in the residential areas. This is due to an overall increase in burglaries

across Charnwood.



On 29/04, PC 1651 and PCSO 6098 attended Thurmaston Brownie group, where they spoke to the children about road safety.

All the children were very engaging and listened well.



On 28/04 PCSO 6024 and 6098 conducted a beat engagement at Thurmaston retail park, allowing residents to raise any concerns.

On 15/04, PCSO 6024 and PC 196 visited the Easter holiday camp at Broomfield Primary school in East Goscote, to engage with the children. This gave them the opportunity to receive a talk about the role and ask any questions.

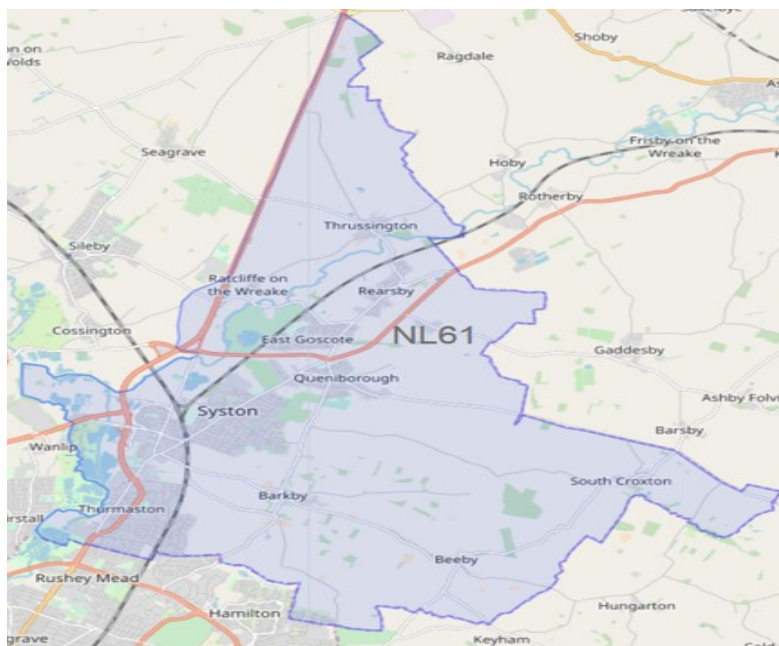
