

Palmers Green Safer Neighbourhood Team News

We have received various reports of anti-social behaviour near the toilets and around the pond areas in Broomfield Park and so have been completing patrols around those areas to discourage any interfering with the wildlife and unwanted behaviour around the toilets. Park users have been happy to see officers and have a chance to ask questions.

We have been using the Palmers Greenery Café to hold our 'Cuppa with a Copper' contact points during the summer months. If you would like to speak to us about an issue, please come along to our next one on 22nd August 3-3.45pm.

On Wednesday 24th June, we attended The Ruth Winston Centre in Palmers Green to give a talk around street safety. The talk included crime prevention around current scams and distraction thefts, bank follow off thefts and card theft, purse and wallet theft, phone theft and Met Engage.



On Thursday 6th August, Palmers Green PCSOs joined forces with Bowes and Highfield PCSOs at Palmers Green Library Dr Bike Repair Session to mark bikes with Bike Register (<https://www.bikeregister.com/>) laminated, tamper resistant warning labels with a unique QR code that can be scanned instantly with a smart phone and deter thieves. For more information about Bike Register please click the link. We had a fairly good attendance and marked 16 bicycles.

We are looking to organise a few more on Bowes Ward, Highfield Ward and Winchmore Hill Ward. Residential Burglary/Non-Residential – June:

HUGUENOT DRIVE – 5.25th, 13th June – 2pm, 15th June. Keys were stolen off the victim's friend and the flat was entered, and an untidy search was completed in every room.

ALDERMANS HILL – 9.40am, 17th June. Suspects have entered the store via the fire exit which triggered the alarm and they have then entered the service yard and taken 10 large orange cones and put them in a van and left.

FOX LANE – 4.45-1130pm, 25th June. Unknown suspect has entered the residential car park/garage and taken the victim's motorcycle.

Please remember to double lock your front doors whether you have a UPVC door or have a Yale and mortice. If you also have a UPVC porch door then double lock that too. If you have the security installed, then please use it.

BOURNE HILL, 6.15-6.20pm, 1st June. A 2018 Nissan Juke was taken without keys.

LODGE DRIVE, 2.15pm, 13th June. An elderly couple were approached by two fake parking attendants and tricked into putting cards into the parking machine receipt slot, speaking their PIN to the machine and the suspects have managed to take both cards and use them before they could be cancelled.

BROOMFIELD LANE, 5.30pm, 21st June. Two males approached the victim from behind by the railway bridge and snatched the victim's phone and ran off across Broomfield Park towards Aldermans Hill.

GREEN LANES, 1.20pm, 18th May. The suspect entered the store and asked the victim for help finding some honey for his wife and while he was talking to the victim, he took £3000 cash from the victim's pocket and ran out of the door.

GROVELANDS ROAD, 7am, 29th May. The victim had his phone snatched from his hand.

The suspect tried to take the victim's phone and then assaulted her when she tried to take it back.

GREEN LANES, 6.36pm, 30th July.
The victim has phone police to report she has been robbed by a male. He made her empty out her pockets while he held a knife on her and then slashed her backpack to get to her tablets.
