#YouSaid - What matters to you

Through Neighbourhood Link, social media and local engagement events, we have listened and will be prioritising:

- **Drug dealing and associated ASB on Kane Close.**

You have raised concerns regarding drug use and the anti-social behaviour associated with this type of criminality.

We have received a number of reports relating to issues surrounding drug use in this area. We have completed a warrant and will continue to work with partners to seek long term solutions.

- **ASB in Coalville Town Centre Following Local Football Matches**

We are aware of continued issues with young people causing general ASB after local football matches.

We are working with local residents, management at the club and partners in problem solving teams to develop long term solutions.

- **Speeding/Nuisance vehicles Ashby Road/London Road.**

We are aware of issues surrounding ongoing issues with inconsiderate and antisocial road use.

We will complete targeted operations in the areas concerned and look to offer education and enforcement where required. We have completed a number of enforcements and have more planned.

Vehicle Seized and Male arrested during proactive foot patrols

Whilst out on foot patrol today, officers spotted a suspicious vehicle in the area. With support from CCTV colleagues, the vehicle was monitored and swiftly stopped by our Neighbourhood Patrol and Safer Streets team. One male was arrested for drug driving and vehicle seized for no insurance


ST. VALENTINE'S DAY Night Time Economy Update
