What we've been doing this month

We kicked off this last month with our ward panel meeting at Cornerstone Community Centre, residents gave over information for SNT to tackle crime and ASB; thank you to all who attended.

In addition to information gathered from the above meeting; SNT continue to carry out regular patrols of the Flaxyard development, Sumner Road Park, pivoting off the Willowbrook Estate to the surrounding areas, combined with our regular school patrols. With the above information we have organised more patrols with Southwark Park Liaison Officers and Community Wardens as they are now able to give out CPW and CPNs.

All of SNTs efforts are periodically supported by Our Town Centre Team who patrol Peckham Square and surrounding areas; and have made a substantial number of stop and searches and arrests.

Another month with a Live Facial Recognition event on our ward (in conjunction with Rye Lane SNT); which included a number of arrests.

Our team also carried out an operation with Market Trading, a number of items were seized and an immigration linked arrest. PC Salter arrested a male for theft of a vehicle, drug offences and multiple driving offences.

PCSOs Baxter and Broughton-Rates are happy to announce that after four weeks of rigourous training; George Desouza, Adrien Dominguez Oviedo and Marcello Stingo have achieved all of their OCPs (needed before going to their wards over Lambeth side) and will be on the streets of Streatham very soon. Congratulations all.
