PREVENTION TALKS / PRESENTATION TO SCHOOLS

With an increase of issues this past AUGUST which involved youths within the community causing ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR issues. PCSO ROBERTSON has been working with our primary schools to attend the schools and provide talks about CRIMES AND CONSQUENCES to Years 5 and 6.

Did you know that at the age of 10, children are criminally responsible and can get arrested. Not many parents know this.

This is the reason why we are attending schools to help prevent and teach the children that their actions can get them into trouble with the police.

In these talks, we are open and honest and discuss past issues, without naming individuals or places that incidents occur. As not all youths know what is classed as ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR. And with that we discuss what is classed as ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR, such as:

- Swearing , shouting
- Throwing items
- Noise (loud music)
- Knock and Run

One of the big issues that we see with the youths is the fact they do KNOCK AND RUN. It may be a game to them , but there is a

Reports should be made to the official numbers so officers that are on duty at the time of report can deal with them (if available)



WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- 2 Male youths riding on off road around the ROSE MEADOW development— PC
 COLLICT was dispatched as working with PCSO ROBERTSON in regards to off road bikes—SEARCH of area made, no trace—PCSO ROBERTSON will see if there is an CCTV available
- Concern in regards to a female as they are not answering their phone—Advised that POLICE wont be attending this
- Further call in regards to the female—AMBULANCE are in attendance therefore there is no reason at present for police to attend.
- Issue of possible harassment which involves threatening language which may be connected to a road traffic accident—RESPONSE officers dispatched and spoke to the reporting person, there is no evidence that this is connected to the road traffic accident, as threatening language was not directed at the reporting person.
- Male looking at vehicles around ARTISAN WAY and when a car comes past he runs off and then comes back—RESPONSE officers dispatched—Search of the area made and there was no trace of the male

HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Van parked fully on the footpath on LONDON ROAD—PCSO ROBERTSON off duty so
 other community dispatched, there was no vehicle present.
- 2nd report in regards to a van parked on the footpath on LONDON ROAD— PCSO HAMBLETON (Shakerley PCSO) was dispatched as PCSO ROBERTSON on leave, there was no vehicle present. Home is getting some work done to it, so maybe it was a delivery van.



LEFTWICH

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Reports of males coming onto the THE WOODPECKER car park and acting suspiciously—Has been logged for INTEL and PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit
- Second report of people looking for a vehicle on the WOODPECKER car park, which
 may be linked to the facebook post of STRANGER DANGER—logged as INTEL,
 reporting person advised no police deployment as there is nothing unlawful
 about people walking around which they understand. LOCAL COMMUNITY
 POLICE TEAM have been aware of this
- Youths on scrambler bikes with the area—Information has been passed onto the LOCAL POLICING TEAM who are looking into this
- Youths in park shining a green laser into peoples windows— RESPONSE OFFICERS
 dispatched and park searched no youths present
- People entering the reporting persons property and taking things without their permission— RESPONSE officers attended and there was no answer at the address and no furter calls
- Concern over a female due a telephone conversation that they just had—RIGHT CARE
 RIGHT PLACE, passed onto AMBULANCE
- Reporting person is the mother of the person, who Is calling them a "BAD MUM" and other threatening language—Due to issues that were disclosed in regards to her son, was advised to contact 111
- Issue with neighbours possibly using cannabis—has been placed as INTEL and PCSO ROBERTSON is working with WEAVER VALE in regards to this issue

KINGSMEAD

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- large fight between two males and there is a baseball bat involved—RESPONSE
 OFFICERS attended, issue is not as reported as there is a disagreement between two males. All parties spoken to as both at fault
- Neighbour banging on door shouting due to the incident above—No Harm as caller stated that neighbour has gone back to her address—PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit
- Issues in KENSINGTON WAY park, with children screaming and shouting from 1630 up to 2000—PCSO ROBERTSON has tried to contact reporting person in regards to this
- After selling a vehicle , the vehicle has broken down and the buyers are sending threatening messages—PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visits
- Two Males taking photographs of a certain building on BLAKEMERE DRIVE, just looked suspicious—Anon report, has been placed as INTEL
- At assault from a carer made by the person who is caring for, saying that they were hit
 over the face— report was made from a care coordinator who is looking into this,
 and the person who did this was suspended.
- Female was hit by a Peddle bike— PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit

BURGULARY

Female reporting that there is a male upstairs who is taking stuff and wont leave—
 RESPONSE officers dispatched and searched the home, there was no on present in the home except

SHOPLIFTING

- Group of 4 youths taking alcohol from TESCO without paying for it—PCSO ROBERTSON was in area as it occurred, youths have been identified and CCTV obtained.
- Incident of shoplifting at TESCO—Crimed and PCSO ROBERTSON will obtain CCTV
- Incident of shoplifting at TESCO by a repeat offender—Crimed and being investigated
- Further issue of shoplifting from TESCO— crimed and being investigated—PCSO ROBERTSON will attend for reassurance for all issues whilst hes been on leave.

THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

 Vehicle taken from TESCO CAR PARK—RESPONSE OFFICERS and PCSO ROBERTSON attended and vehicle was located in a different parking spot

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

 Youths throwing eggs over car and property — PCSO ROBERTSON will call for reassurance and has been given details from another party who could be involved in this

DAVENHAM

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Youths throwing sticks over the hedge from BUTCHERS STILE—CCTV will be checked by PCSO ROBERTSON
- Concern over a male, who got some fuel and did not have any methods of payment.
 After filling up a cannister of fuel he arranged a taxi to take him home to LEFTWICH and has left car behind in DAVENHAM—RIGHT CARE RIGHT PERSON (Ambulance) no police deployment
- Reporting person found a male sitting on a bench which was in their front garden, possibly under the influence—Intel has been placed, PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit
- Further report in regards to a male who was now at another bench, possibly under the influence. Not moving but conscious—Not a police issue— RIGHT CARE RIGHT PERSON (Ambulance)
- Further report in regards to the male, male has now gone, but there was a knife found near the bench— RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched, Knife located and booked in for destruction at Northwich
- Issue in regards to a tree which is one neighbours land, that needs cutting—There is a dispute over the land issue, POLICE do not get involved in land deeds, therefore is a civil issue. However RESPONSE officers have spoken to neighbours who state that they are offering to pay for it to be cut for the reporting person

BURGULARY

Laptop has been taken from property—RESPONSE officers have attended and CSI are looking into this— PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit

MOULTON

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

• Concern over a male who may be harming himself—No police deployment, RIGHT CARE RIGHT PLACE—caller advised to contact AMBULANCE

SHOPLIFTING

 Male putting Beer down his pants—CRIMED . PCSO ROBERTSON will attend to gain CCTV so this can be looked into

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Vehicle has had side window smashed, which may be in relation to ongoing issues with another male—NO CCTV, so nothing for CSI to investigate. PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit
