

East Sheen

Police responded to a report of a missing East Sheen resident, which was made by his ex-partner. Officers immediately initiated enquiries and coordinated efforts to locate the individual. Within 12 hours of the report, the male was found in the Kingston area. He was confirmed to be safe and well. A full welfare check was carried out, and officers conducted a debrief to ensure appropriate safeguarding measures were in place.

Officers on patrol observed an altercation outside Waitrose on Upper Richmond Road West. Upon intervention, they discovered approximately 14 school-aged youths harassing store security and staff after being banned from the premises the previous day. Officers quickly brought the situation under control and dispersed the group.

Following the incident, East Sheen officers reviewed body-worn video footage and circulated images internally. A local school assisted in identifying the individuals involved. Officers then visited the school, engaging with staff and the parents of those concerned. Verbal warnings were issued, and the importance of respectful behaviour in the community was reinforced.



Kew

Police officers successfully recovered over £650 worth of beauty products stolen from a BOOTS store. Further investigation revealed that this incident is connected to approximately 17 other offences across the Metropolitan area. Enquiries are ongoing to identify and apprehend those responsible.

Officers recently conducted an investigation involving possession of Class B cannabis, theft of a motor vehicle, and suspected use of criminal property. The suspect was observed driving past police at speed, prompting officers to follow and stop the individual. A search was carried out under relevant powers, during which a snap bag containing cannabis was discovered inside the delivery box of the suspect's moped.

Additionally, a significant amount of cash was found in the suspect's trouser pocket. The suspect was arrested on suspicion of possession of Class B drugs, theft of a motor vehicle, and proceeds of crime, as the cash was believed to have been obtained through criminal activity.

North Richmond

An off-duty officer in North Richmond observed a male leaving Sainsbury's after allegedly stealing several items. The officer discreetly maintained surveillance and followed the suspect to an address nearby, while keeping a low profile. Local units were then deployed to assist, and entry was gained to the property. The suspect was arrested for theft-related offences and further arrested for assaulting store staff during the incident. This swift action demonstrates the dedication of officers both on and off duty to keeping our community safe.



Police were alerted by a North Richmond resident that their Range Rover had been stolen. Initial checks revealed the vehicle was already showing as missing approximately 70+ miles away from the registered address. Officers quickly circulated the details and utilised the manufacturer's factory tracking system to trace the vehicle's location. Thanks to this rapid response and coordinated effort, the Range Rover was successfully recovered and returned to its rightful owner.
