

Kidbrooke Village & Sutcliffe Ward

Your Safer Neighbourhood Team joined the fun with the Chinese New Year celebration at the Kidbrooke Community Hub, this event brought together vibrant culture and community interaction highlighting a variety of performances.

The Team achieved 6 positive outcomes for shoplifting offences charging prolific shoplifters in Greenwich Borough and 4 arrests for public order and burglary. 1 stolen motorbike recovered. We dealt with numerous ASB issues around the ward and drug related offences.

This is still an ongoing issue that we take very seriously, and we will continue to target over the coming weeks by undertaking proactive high-visibility and plain clothes patrols.
