Anti-Social Use of Motorbikes

The Nuneaton Safer Neighbourhood Team were busy in August tackling this issue, when one day they came across a



group of seven motorbike riders who suddenly seemed to have the urge to ride away. Two of them struggled to get their engines started, so left without their bikes. One rider even left behind his "lovely" helmet, but if he would like it back, he could call into the station for a friendly chat. Two of the bikes turned out to be stolen and displaying the wrong plates, so they were seized and will soon be reunited with their rightful owners.







Arrests for Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) in Nuneaton

In August, two women from Nuneaton were arrested as part of an investigation into an interaction between several members of the public that has been widely shared on social media and in the news. The footage showed members of



the public being subjected to racial abuse, with one reportedly being pushed. A 30-year-old woman from Nuneaton was arrested on suspicion of a public order offence. A second woman from Nuneaton, aged 43, was arrested on suspicion of a public order offence and of racially aggravated common assault. Both women were later bailed with conditions - among them to not enter Nuneaton town centre.

Action to Stop Drug Dealing

In September, as part of our ongoing work to disrupt drug supply, an officer from the Safer Neighbourhood Team stopped a vehicle in the Camphill/Kingswood area, that was linked

to suspected criminal activity. A search under the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 led to the recovery of: three bags of suspected Class B drugs (Ketamine as shown in the picture), and £1,100 of cash, concealed in a black Nike bag. A man was arrested on suspicion of Possession With Intent to Supply a Class B drug and taken into custody. This result highlights our determination to remove drugs from our streets and to take action against those looking to profit from supplying them.

Man Charged with Assault

In September, a man aged 19 was arrested and charged with common assault and assault by beating, following an incident on High Street, Nuneaton.



He will appear at Warwickshire Magistrates' Court in October 2025.

Arrest for Snatching Phone

In September, the SNT were called to a report of a woman having her phone snatched on High Street in Nuneaton and a 19-year-old man was arrested.

An investigation was carried out into this,



amid wider concerns that had been raised and discussed on social media.
