Hello, everyone!

We can only apologise for the delayed update. This is your current ward update for Brunswick and Adelaide, looking back at the month just gone, and offering current crime prevention advice.



Within the month of June:

- Reports of ASB increased to 52 reports.
- There was one report of burglary.
- There were 10 reports of criminal damage.



Patrols:

There were 15 patrols within the month of June. The average patrol time was 107 minutes. This is the second highest average across all of Brighton and Hove.

Specifics:

- 2 reports of people being bitten by dogs.
- 1 report of stones being thrown at wildlife.
- 1 report of attempted theft of a moped.
- 1 stolen bike and 1 stolen handbag from Hove Lawns.
- Several reports of music-related noise disturbance.



Key Priorities:

- To keep visibility high and maintain strong patrols in the B&A area. Focus will be kept on green spaces and community gardens to ensure unwanted behaviour does not persist in these areas.
