ASB remains one of the beat priorities.	Attended a report of ASB issues in Desford where both victim and neighbours have been visited. Enquiries ongoing. we attended a park in Ratby, after there were reports of some youths who were smoking cannabis. When we arrived, we conducted an area search of the park and surrounding area but no youths, to be found. Foot patrols have been completed in various locations along with hi-visibility mobile patrols.
Road safety – numerous reports of overweight vehicles and speeding motorists within the villages.	Conducted stop checks on several vehicles across the area, checking on vehicle and driver details.

Local officers from the Market Bosworth beat team along with officers from the Leicestershire and Rutland rural crime team attended the area of Orton on the hill and surrounding areas following reports of hare coursing. A short time later a car with two occupants with a dog inside was stopped. The car had no TAX, the driver was also found to have no licence so the vehicle, dog and other items were recovered and the driver was reported for driving offences.

SC Rebecca and PC Eden attended an RTC near Mallory Park. It was van vs van and luckily no injuries. However, both vans came off worse for wear.. one van was stationed in a lay-by, but the other was partially in the road so needed recovering. Van recovered, road cleared and reopened. Apologies to any of the motorists who were slightly delayed, for the firework show. We did have a nice view of some fireworks though.

The team attended the Mayflower club in Markfield where we were invited to come along and speak with several residents. We were joined here with Angela from Hinkley and Bosworth Borough Council community safety and a Police volunteer where security equipment was available as well as providing crime safety advice around home safety, fraud awareness and other topics.



A report from Leicestershire Fire and Rescue Service Southern Station meant we have assisted them with road closures following a caravan that had been dumped and set alight in Desford.

Unfortunately this month we said a very sad goodbye to PCSO Niko (3rd from the right). Niko has been with us for many years but luckily for us he will start his new role within Leicestershire Police at our Force Headquarters. Good Luck Niko.

Our local beat team officers PC Smith and PCSO Needham along with colleagues from Leicestershire Fire and Rescue Hinckley Station, officers from Hinckley and Bosworth Borough Council teams including Anti-social behaviour, Housing, Community Safety as well as local councillor Michael Mullaney joined forces for a community patchwalk in the Preston Drive area of Newbold Verdon. Here we were able to speak to local residents about Crime, Anti-social behaviour and any other issues that may affect them. We were able to sign people up to Neighbourhood link service that we provide.
