## What have we done? #WeDid



To promote safety during the night time economy we have deployed on Operation Oversee which sees our officers conducting visits at licensed premises to ensure they are operate legally and safety, as well as conducting checks on SIA door staff. We served 4 warnings, had 2 licenses revoked and reported 4 door supervisors to the SIA.

We have also been present in key locations in the City Centre promoting the Ask Angela campaign and giving out free anti-spiking equipment and advice. We have deployed plain clothes officers to tackle violence against women and girls during the NTE.

To tackle and prevent burglary in the City Centre we have been working with our business retailers, holding engagement events and sharing best practice to help prevent offences and target harden their stores.

We have had some significant results arresting numerous suspects for burglary offences and so far this year we have had 10 criminal behaviour orders served against prolific offenders banning them from the City Centre and other locations they have targeted.

Target high visibility patrols have been completed regularly in known hotspot areas, these patrols have help us achieve the fantastic results we have had.





We remain committed to tackling anti-social behaviour at the Town Hall Square. We have deployed with a drugs dog multiple times as part of Operation Swam and we have made significant arrets for drugs related offences.

We have utilised our powers in line with the public space protection order and made more than 15 alcohol seizures in this area.

We have focused our patrols in this area and our PCSO colleagues have been holding regular engagement events in the area.

## Other news

We have been tackling vehicle ASB on Granby street . 7 tickets issued, 3 vehicles seized, 5 ASB warnings, 1 stop search with drugs recovered and 1 suspect arrested.
