Acting on Community Concerns

Anti-Social Behaviour -General, E-Scooters and Nuisance Motorcycles, Theft-Shoplifting

Town Centre

This month has seen lots of good work in and around the Town Centre. Beat Officers have given a number of Community Resolutions for Cannabis possession offense which have been as a result of stop searches.

Officers have been out through nighttime economy with Enforcement Officers from Ashford Borough Council conducting routine licencing visits. During this month's engagement, we arrested an outstanding suspect for Theft Shoplifting offences after finding him en-route to one of our venues. We issued two further Community Resolutions relating to Cannabis possession and dealt with two drivers for traffic related issues. One was issued a S.59 Warning for driving in an anti-social manner after being seen wheel spinning and driving at speed along Bank Street. The second driver, was stopped after being seen found by Officers to drive the wrong way along a one-way road. He has reported for driving carelessly and due to already having points on his licence, is likely to lose this following a Court date.

A further incident saw a male arrested for breaching his Criminal Behaviour Order, in which he is excluded from the Town Centre as a whole. He was remanded to Court following arrest as was his associate who also happened to be breaching separate Court Bail conditions.
