Officers attended an emergency response to reports of a male walking in live lanes on the A50 near Groby. On arrival, we found him safely off the road. He explained he was walking from Leicester to Coalville and living rough until moving into new accommodation later that week. Given the dangers of walking along a busy dual carriageway, we gave him a short lift to safety and wished him well for the future.

The Team have been so busy during December, in just one shift the Officers accomplished the following; **Suspicious Activity** – Contact made with a member of the public in Barlestone regarding concerns. **High-Visibility Patrols** – Increased presence through many villages, including Stoke Golding following thefts from vans, and Fenny Drayton & Orton on the Hill due to recent hare coursing incidents. **Community Engagement** – Visited Brookvale

Groby Learning Campus to support students and staff. **Partnership Working** – Engaged with Hinckley Borough Council regarding a criminal damage incident. **Neighbour Dispute** – Assisted with a local dispute in Barlestone. **Break-in Report** – Supported response officers attending a break-in in progress in Hinckley. **Crime Queue Enquiries** – Completed investigations in Groby and Sheepy Magna. **Court Summons** – Delivered on behalf of Scottish Courts. **ASB Reports** – Attended reports of anti-social behaviour in Newbold Verdon and Ratby. Busy, Busy, Busy!
