





The service helps us keep you upto-date by letting you know what is happening in your area as well as providing crime prevention advice, information about appeals and community events. It also allows you to directly respond to us with information about any crimes or appeals.

The service is free to register and you can sign up as an individual or a business. You can also choose what information you want to be told about and how often you receive it.
