



Neighbourhood Policing Update

We would like to provide residents with an update on recent policing activity within the local area.

Barrow upon Soar – Car Meets

Officers have been carrying out patrols around reported car meets in **Barrow upon Soar**. These patrols are focused on preventing anti-social behaviour, ensuring road safety, and engaging with local residents. The beat team will continue to monitor the area and respond to any concerns raised.

King George V Park – Criminal Damage

We have received reports of **criminal damage at King George V Park**. Officers have been conducting regular patrols within the park, and enquiries are currently ongoing. We are working to identify those responsible and will take appropriate action. Residents are encouraged to report any suspicious activity to assist with these enquiries.

Speeding Concerns – Barrow upon Soar

Concerns have been raised by residents regarding vehicles speeding in **Barrow upon Soar**, particularly along key routes through the village. Arrangements have been made for a **speed enforcement van** to visit Barrow upon Soar to address the issue and promote safer driving behaviour.

The presence of the speed enforcement van will act as both a deterrent and an enforcement measure, with the aim of reducing vehicle speeds and improving safety for the local community. Further monitoring and patrols will continue, and residents are encouraged to report ongoing concerns to help inform future activity.

Sileby – Reports of Quad Bikes

Reports have been received regarding the use of **quad bikes around the Sunnylands Drive area of Sileby**. Officers have carried out patrols in response and further enquiries are ongoing. This activity continues to be monitored, and patrols will remain in place to deter unsafe or anti-social use of vehicles. Residents are encouraged to report any sightings promptly to assist us in responding effectively.

Sileby – Memorial Park Reassurance Patrols

Reassurance patrols are taking place in **Sileby**, with particular attention around **Memorial Park**. These patrols provide a visible police presence, help deter anti-social behaviour, and offer reassurance to park users and nearby residents.

Police Cadets – Community Engagement - Working with the Community

Police Cadets have been carrying out door-to-door visits and surveys in **Wymeswold and Barrow upon Soar** as part of the **Neighbourhood Link** initiative. This engagement helps to gather community feedback, provide crime prevention advice, and strengthen links between residents and local policing teams. The cadets will be undertaking further visits in the future. Please be assured that all cadets are clearly identifiable and supervised at all times.

Information from residents helps us target patrols and address issues that matter most locally. If you witness anti-social behaviour or have concerns, please report them via **101**, or **999 in an emergency**.

Beat Priorities

#YouSaid - What matters to you

- We have received reports of antisocial behaviour involving the misuse of e-bikes, as well as groups throwing eggs, kicking doors, and causing damage to vehicles.
- Burglaries remain a priority for the beat team and we will be looking to reduce this with the high visibility patrols within targeted areas.
- There has been a small rise in theft-from-motor-vehicle incidents in the NL59 area toward the end of 2025.

The beat team will work to reduce these offences through targeted high-visibility patrols. We will also engage with residents in the affected areas to provide crime prevention advice and discuss appropriate security measures.

#WeDid - What we are doing













- We are collaborating with partner agencies to tackle reported incidents of antisocial behaviour within the village and surrounding parks. Those identified will be managed through a stepped warning process to address their behaviour.
Enhanced patrols will be conducted to identify offenders, with the potential seizure of bikes linked to the reported concerns.
There will also be an increase in evening patrols, supported by the deployment of the ASB vehicle, to focus on individuals involved in these incidents.
- Officers will engage with affected community members to offer crime prevention guidance and assess improvements to home security across the area. Intelligence-led enquiries will be carried out to identify suspects and disrupt burglary-related criminality.
- We will continue targeted patrols in identified hotspot areas to deter further offences and identify those responsible. Officers will work with local residents to provide practical crime-prevention advice and support measures that reduce opportunities for theft from motor vehicles. We will also collaborate with partner agencies to address any recurring issues and put longer-term solutions in place to reduce vehicle-related crime in the area.
