#YouSaid - What matters to you - Priorities

We have listened to your concerns and will prioritise the following areas:

Priority 1

Dangerous and illegal use of vehicles around the Western Ward continue to be reported and raised as concerns by local residents. Speeding, E-bikes and E-Scooters and dangerous parking outside Primary Schools have all been highlighted.

Actions— The beat team have continued to target area's where this type of issue is most prevalent

Priority 2

The community in the area of Styon Road, Kemp Road and Lamem Road tell us that youths are regularly causing Anti-Social Behaviour in and around the grassed Play area. Motorcycle gatherings causing excessive noise, Vandalism/damage to Property, targeting of a vulnerable residents and incidents of animal cruelty have all been reported.

Actions— High visibility patrols on dedicated days and times throughout the month to identify perpetrators.

Priority 3

Retail crime continues to be a problem for our shops across the Western ward which is causing staff to feel unsafe whilst at work.

Actions— We continue to maintain a good working relationship and open communication sharing information to tackle the persistent offenders bring them to justice


#WeDid - Snapshots

The team have had a very positive result in the court this month with us being granted a partial closure order to a property on Chainama Close. This prevents any persons other than what was agreed at court access to the property. This although in its early days has had a massive impact on the ASB that was being caused in an address

Operation Zig Zag—We continue to target poor parking outside of our schools at drop of and pick ups, we would urge all parents who drive their children to school to be considerate or face being given a ticket...

New tactics employed—This month the beat team have entered new territory and had 2 Civil injunction hearings at court. These were upheld into interim orders until the full hearing in May. 

Whilst on patrol PC Georgia, spotted a local male wanted for a burglary at his family home. The male was on his bike so Dan gave chase, assisted by Georgia who was telling him where to go to cut the male off (Dan is still getting to know the area) and tackled him off the bike and arrested him. The incident was passed over to CID. Despite the family not making a complaint we were successful in getting a Domestic Violence Protection Order (DVPO) which protects the family for 28 days where the male is not allowed anywhere near the family home.
