#YouSaid - What matters to you

We have listened to you, your concerns and will prioritise the following areas:

Priority 1: Criminality and Anti-Social Behaviour

Your Concerns: Cropston Close, Leicester has seen a considerable increase in crime and disorder in the last couple of months leading to officers being assaulted and numerous items of stolen property being recovered from the street.

Our Actions:

- A meeting with Riverside Housing on 9th October took place and was productive. 2 families have been identified and have or are moving out of the area. Other offenders have been visited on the 31st October and have been issued with Acceptable behaviour contracts and community protection warnings.

Priority 2: Criminality and Anti-Social Behaviour

Your Concerns: Crime and disorder continue to be reported in Bonney Road including vehicles being stolen, disorder and person carrying weapons. These reports make residents feel unsafe in their own neighbourhood.

Our Actions:

- High visibility and plain clothed patrols of Bonney Road were carried out throughout October and there were no instances of Disorder or stolen vehicle reported. One offender attended court on the 28th October for previous offences. They will be due to attend court again in November.
- Applying for Leicestershire's first gang injunction at the County Court. This work seeks to disrupt the activities and offending being reported.

Priority 3: Dangerous Driving

Your Concerns: Dangerous and illegal use of vehicles around the Western Ward continue to be reported and raised as concerns by local residents especially at our Ward meeting during August.

Our Actions:

- Operation took place on Mary road on the 4th October no offences were witnessed.
- Op ZigZag gas took place on a number of days throughout October and 5 tickets were issued to offenders parking dangerously


News and Community Events October 25




Beat Surgeries
