What we've been doing this month - The team have successfully liaised with the local council in order to install gates on the entrances of the Hankey Place Underpass which has been a great help for the residents near Long Lane / Tabard Estate

-More streetlink referrals have been made to the homeless individuals that have been frequenting the ward.

-Leading into the summer months, Chaucer Ward have been making sure that they have been conducting many late night patrols around the ward. This is because there has again, been another spike in the amount of phone snatches and other attempts of personal robbery. The main roads to look out for in terms of this offence are: Great Dover Street, Borough High Street, Long Lane, Manciple Street and Tabard Street.

-The PCSO's have successfully created and sent off a request for new robbery signs which we are hoping will help people be more aware when commuting.

-Chaucer SNT have completed many open space patrols around the different parks in the ward. Such as, Tabard Gardens, Newington Gardens, Dickens Field Park and Falmouth Road Park. This has been a useful tool for the team as it has allowed us to gain intelligence and help us understand where we need to prioritise. But also, it's great to engage with residents and enjoy the sun whilst staying safe.

-Officers have been working really hard to engage with lots of the residents from the ward as a new platform 'Met Engage' has been released. This has included adding daily updates and pictures from each shift. Please make sure you all spread the word regarding the new 'Met Engage' platform!!
