Join us via one of our entry routes:

Police Constable Degree Apprenticeship (PCDA)

A fully funded three-year programme where you can earn as you learn gaining a (BSc) Hons degree in professional policing practice on completion with one of our partner universities. After an initial learning period at uni you'll

join a team of experienced officers who'll pass on their invaluable skills for you to put into practice policing London's streets.

Police Constable Entry Programme (PCEP)

A two-year programme providing new recruits with a blend of classroom based and operational learning. Initial training will take place at a Met training centre before you join one of our experienced policing teams to gain practical, on-the-job experience.

You'll be regularly assessed on your knowledge, skills and behaviours but, unlike our other entry route, you will not be required to complete an academic qualification as part of your training or attend university.
