



Know When to Call the Police!

The police are here to help keep everyone safe! But we must use their help the right way.

In an emergency:

Call 999 🚨

f If someone is in danger f you see a crime happening If there's a fire or accident l Only call 999 if it's a real emergency!

Be ready to tell the police: What happened Where it happened Who was involved Vour name and age

For non-emergencies:

Call 101

If something has already happened (like a stolen bike) f you want to tell the police something important but it's not urgent. Try telling a trusted adult / teacher first if it's not an emergency.

REMEMBER:

Don't prank call the police — it can stop them from helping someone who really needs it and it is a crime!

Remember: Be Smart. Be Safe. Be Kind. Only call when you really need help!
