Tackling drug supply and linked violence remains a priority with Op Continuum, a Hackney and Tower Hamlets operation to tackle drug supply.

Increased visibility of police was commonly noted by residents. We have responded to this and the majority of time will patrol in full uniform.

Your Dedicated Ward Officers

Dedicated Ward Officers conduct regular highly visible patrols across the ward to deter and disrupt criminal activity and Anti-Social Behaviour. They hold regular crime prevention events, public contact sessions and community meetings to hear about the issues that matter most to you. They also carry out proactive police work to deter, disrupt, and detect crime.

What's been happening in your Area


In recent weeks Officers have carried out many proactive patrols in the wards most significant hotspots for drug related ASB and drug dealing.





Community Safety Updates

Weavers SNT officers carried out weapon sweeps during September and found an 18 inch Zombie knife hidden inside Ravenscroft Park next to the children's play area.



Op Eridani in Whitechapel Road

Part of Op ERIDANI—Spitalfields officers target WHITECHAPEL crime/ASB, hotspot Court Street. A Stop & Search of a male led to finding 55 wraps of class A drugs. Arrested, drugs removed from the streets. Ongoing investigation.

Op Nightingale



Op Nightingale—Hexagon has started. It is a Central Violent Crime Task Force lead Operation to reduce violent crime within identified hotspots. Proactive operations to bring offenders to justice and reduce violent crime. On the first day of Op Hexagon a male was arrested for recall to prison. Some of the roads covered for one of the hexagons include Rochelle Street, Montclare Street, Nichol Street, Redchurch Street, Brick Lane, Swanfield Street, Chambord Street, Tomlinson Close, Shacklewell Street and Bethnal Green Road.
